By The Court to Sherry Bricker:

Q. How old are you, Miss?

A. 11.

Q. Proceed.

SHERRY L. BRICKER, being duly sworn according to law, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By Mr. Ertel:

Q. Sherry, state your full name?

A. Sherry Lynn Bricker.

Q. Sherry, the girl who was just in here was Cindy, your sister?

A. Yes.

Q. She is your twin?

A. Yes.

Q. Turning back to the 19th of October, do you recall seeing Jennifer Hill on that particular day?

A. Yes.

Q. When was the first time you saw her, if you recall?

Sherry Bricker.

A. I don't know.

A. About a half hour.

Q. Where did you go from there?

A. We went home.

Q. Did Jennifer go with you?

A. No.

Q. All right, did you see Jennifer again?

A. No, she went home.

Q. Did you see Jennifer anymore that day?

A. No.

Q. Do you recall being at the Hum-Dinger?

A. Yes.

Q. What time were you at the Hum-Dinger?

A. I don't know.

Q. Was Jennifer with you at the Hum-Dinger?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you recall having some food at the Hum-Dinger?

Sherry Bricker.

A. Yes.

Q. What did you all have to eat there?

A. Jennifer had a "sub".

Q. That is a hoagie?

A. Yes.

Q. Did she have anything else?

A. A milk shake.

Q. How about anything else?

A. That is all.

Q. Did she have any of your food?

Q. Well, the grape place, or where ever that is?

A. No.

CROSS EXAMINATION

By Mr. Fierro:

- Q. Sherry, you say you played football at the Super-Duper?
- A. Yes.
- Q. You mean just you four girls or were there other people?
- A. There was other people.
- Q. Boys too?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Was it a sort of a rough and tumble game?
- A. Yes.
- Q. How long do you think you played football?
- A. About a half hour.
- Q. You say that sometime that afternoon you did go with your sister to the Hubbard house?
- A. Yes.

Q. But you didn't stay long?

A. No.

Q. Did you see Kim Hubbard's car?

A. I don't remember.

Q. You don't remember?

A. Nope.

Q. You just stayed outside?

A. Yes.

Q. Did you see your sister go inside of the Hubbard house?

A. No.

A. Yes.

Q. While she was leaning against the car, did anybody come out of the Hubbard house?

A. No.

A. No.

Q. That is all.

(Excused from witness stand.)

By The Court to Johane Hurley:

Q. How old are you, Miss?

A. 12.

Q. Proceed.

JOHANE HURLEY, being duly sworn according to law,
testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By Mr. Ertel:

Q. State your name?

A. Johane Hurley, Johane Michelle Hurley.

Q. Do they call you Michelle?

A. Yes.

Q. Where do you live?

A. 1137 West Central Avenue.

Q. Is that very far from the Bricker home?

A. No.

Q. About how far, do you know?

A. Across the street.

Q. How far is it from the Hubbard place?

A. A couple blocks down.
