- Q. How old are you, Miss?
- A. 11.
- Q. Proceed.

SHERRY L. BRICKER, being duly sworn according to law, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By Mr. Ertel:

- Q. Sherry, state your full name?
- A. Sherry Lynn Bricker.
- Q. Sherry, the girl who was just in here was Cindy, your sister?
 - A. Yes.
 - Q. She is your twin?
 - A. Yes.
- Q. Turning back to the 19th of October, do you recall seeing Jennifer Hill on that particular day?
 - A. Yes.
 - Q. When was the first time you saw her, if you recall?

 - Q. Well, the grape place, or where ever that is?

- A. We went down to the Super-Duper lot.
- Q. Did Jennifer go there with you?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Do you know what time it was by any chance?
- A. No.
- Q. And after you were at Super-Duper, what did you do there, incidentally?
 - A. We played football.
 - Q. What happened after that?
 - A. We all went home.
 - Q. Did you see Jennifer anymore that day?
 - A. No.
 - Q. Did you go to the Hubbard house also with your

sister?

- A. Just for a little bit.
- Q. Went to the Hubbard home?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Did you see Jennifer there?
- A. No.
- Q. Did you see Ruthie?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Do you know when you were at the Hubbard home?
- A. No.
- Q. You can't recall the time?
- A. Ho.
